15 points maximum; were the project goals, and any technical results to date clearly presented? Were the technical or functional specifications carefully and realistically described. Is it clear what the project is supposed to do?

3. Methodology

20 points maximum; Was the design process clearly described? Was the design process technically appropriate? We appropriate references included?

4. Results and Performance

15 points maximum; Which specifications were achieved? Which were not and why? Can the design be improved upon or done in a better way?

5. Administrative

15 points maximum; Is it clear who did what? Was the project plan followed? Were any major changes in the project plan and the reasons for them described?

6. Design Implications

5 points maximum; Was there an adequate explanation of any implications or concerns relevant to cost, ethics, environmental impact, sustainability, manufacturability, health & safety, or social or political impact.

7. Conclusions and Continuing Work

5 points maximum; Were the conclusions appropriate? Is it clear what worked and what did not. Was the future of this project clearly described?

Professional Presentation

10 points maximum; Were all Sections presented clearly and concisely without rambling or wordy sentences, without a diary or sequential style, and without the use of a 1st person narrative? Were all charts, graphics, lists or diagrams presented clearly?
